On April 8, 2025, the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") requested approval of an electronic version of the Statement of Claimant form that ADWR intends to provide on the agency's website. A series of attachments to the request demonstrated how previously filed SOCs appear with the data entered into the proposed online form.

ADWR's efforts to modernize water adjudication processes where possible is applauded and staff from the Office of the Special Master will certainly participate in any user testing. While the new online form looks different because of changes in typography, all the necessary information is included. Recognizing that even if the form

is more accessible, the form still may be challenging for some claimants regarding what information is being requested, therefore it is expected that explanations and instructions will be easily available, and as intuitive as possible, to further assist claimants.

ADWR also stated in their request, that based upon the agency's reading of the Court's March 6, 2023, Order Regarding Form Verification, "standard notarization would still be required for all SOC forms." At this juncture in ADWR's process improvement journey, "standard notarization" may still be the most efficient way to verify a signature, however it is not the only method, nor the "required" method, and ADWR is encouraged to continue evaluating alternatives as the agency's, and the court's, technical capabilities improve.

IT IS ORDERED approving ADWR's PDF output form for the online SOC as proposed and allowing for ADWR to make any non-substantive design changes.
