The United States filed an Amended Report dated July 28, 2017, that identified three wilderness areas in the San Pedro River watershed for which it had not filed a statement of claimant: Miller Peak Wilderness Area, Galiuro Wilderness Area, and the Rincon Mountain Wilderness Area. Due to the expressed legislative desire for an early determination of Indian and

non-Indian federal water claims, deadlines were set by which the United States would file its claims for water rights to wilderness areas in the San Pedro River Watershed. In anticipation of the United States' deadline for filing a statement of claimant for the Miller Peak Wilderness Area, Freeport Minerals Corporation moved for the initiation of a contested case to address the claims asserted by the United States. On the due date for filing a statement of claimant for the Miller Peak Wilderness Area, the United States filed a notice that it elected not to file a claim for the Miller Peak Wilderness Area.

The statutory provisions governing the adjudication of water rights require the existence of a claimant defined as a person claiming water rights. A.R.S. §§45-251, 45-257. In the absence of a statement of claimant from the United States for water rights to Miller Peak Wilderness Area, no claim exists for Arizona Department of Water Rights to investigate pursuant to A.R.S. §45-256 or for the court to adjudicate pursuant to A.R.S. §45-257.

IT IS ORDERED denying Freeport Minerals Corporation's Motion to Initiate a Contested Case to Address the Federal Reserved Right Claims Asserted by the U.S. Forest Service for Miller Peak Wilderness Area.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the United States shall file by December 3, 2018, a report on the status of its preparation of statements of claimant for the Galiuro and Rincon Mountain Wilderness Areas.
