issuance of San Pedro I, additional statements of claimant have been filed asserting water rights in the San Pedro Basin. On June 21, 2016, this Court issued an Order directing the Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) to prepare an HSR to analyze all statements of claimant filed for water rights in the San Pedro Basin that are not analyzed in Subsequent to the issuance of the Order for the San Pedro II HSR, the San Pedro I. statutes governing this adjudication were amended. To advance the adjudication and the efficiency of the process, the Order for the San Pedro II HSR is hereby revised to direct the ADWR to analyze the claims for water rights in the Sierra Vista subwatershed of the San Pedro Basin not included in San Pedro I and prepare a HSR which shall be known as the San Pedro II-Sierra Vista HSR. Additional orders will be issued in the future as appropriate to direct the preparation of HSRs for the remaining subwatersheds in the San Pedro Basin. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that Arizona Department of Water Resources shall prepare a preliminary HSR known as San Pedro II-Sierra Vista in compliance with A.R.S.§ 45-256, which shall include the following information:

- 1. Proposed water right attributes for each claim made in the statements of claimant, which are:
 - i. Type of water use;
 - Applicable filings made with ADWR; ii.
 - Source of water; iii.
 - Legal description of point of diversion of the water; iv.
 - Legal description of place of use of the water; v.

- vi. Quantity of use in acre feet per year; and
- vii. Dates on which any use of water listed in the statements of claimant began or ceased.

If applicable, water attributes will also include storage volume, name of reservoir or stock pond, and number of irrigated acres.

- 2. The priority date claimed in each statement of claimant for each proposed water right.
- 3. Fee ownership of the land to which the water rights will be appurtenant.
- 4. Identification of the claims which qualify as *de minimis* claims pursuant to the Special Master's Memorandum Decision, Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law for Group I Cases Involving Stockwatering, Stockponds and Domestic Uses ("*De Minimis* Decision"), dated November 14, 1994, modified on February 23, 1995, as approved and modified by court order dated September 26, 2002.
- 5. A statement that clearly identifies those claims for which the Director of Arizona Department of Water Resources does not make a recommendation concerning the water rights claimed and uses investigated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon completion of the preliminary report, ADWR shall comply with PreTrial Order No. 5 Re: Notice of Hydrographic Survey Reports, dated March 29, 2000. The geographic area covered by the HSR shall be the Sierra Vista subwatershed.
