**ORDER SETTING ORAL ARGUMENT  
ON THE NAVAJO NATION'S MOTION  
TO DESIGNATE ISSUE OF BROAD  
LEGAL IMPORTANCE REGARDING  
TRIBAL FEDERAL RESERVED  
WATER RIGHTS**

On July 16, 2018, the Navajo Nation filed a motion to designate issues regarding the quantification, priority, enforcement and administration of federal reserved water rights on Indian reservation as issues of broad legal importance. Pursuant to Pre-Trial Order No. 1, responses to the motion shall be filed by August 27, 2018. Replies will be filed by September 20, 2018.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that oral argument shall be held on the Navajo Nation's Motion to Designate Issue of Broad Legal Importance Regarding Tribal Federal Reserved Water Rights on October 30, 2018 at 1:30 p.m. in the Superior Court of Arizona, Central Court Building, Courtroom 301, 201 West Jefferson Street, Phoenix, AZ, 85003-2202.


