the United States' approach is reasonable given the circumstances, at this point it does appear necessary to stay all deadlines through 2020. Thus, only the most immediate deadlines will be stayed or vacated as specifically listed:

IT IS ORDERED:

- (a) The deadline for the United States' Response to the Motion to Dismiss filed by the City of Flagstaff is stayed.
- (b) The deadline for the United States to file its Sixth Amended Statement of Claimant is stayed.
- (c) The deadline for all parties to file Replies in support of the Motion to Dismiss is stayed.
- (d) The deadlines for all parties to file Responses and Replies to the Motion for Judgment on Partial Findings are stayed. The oral argument on the Motion to Dismiss scheduled for February 21, 2019 is vacated.
- (e) The date for the oral argument on the Motion for Judgment on Partial Findings scheduled for February 28, 2019 is vacated.
- (f) The pre-trial conference scheduled for February 21, 2019 at 1:30 p.m. in Maricopa County Superior Court, Central Court Building, Courtroom 301, 201 W. Jefferson, Phoenix, Arizona 85003 is not vacated. Unless the lapse in appropriations extends beyond February 21, 2019, the parties should expect to appear at a pre-trial conference on February 21, 2019.
