Discussion is held regarding exhibits. Pursuant to the discussion held on the record on September 15, 2020,

LET THE RECORD REFLECT that copies of Figures 2, 9, and 16 of U.S. Exhibit 1239 are marked for identification as Hopi Tribe exhibits 4587, 4588, and 4589 and received in evidence.

Discussion is held regarding the Court's procedure to respond to bench memorandum. Ms. Willard states that the City of Flagstaff filed a bench memorandum. The Court is inclined to set a response date to bench memorandum on the Monday following the filing unless it is something that needs to be addressed right away.

There being no objection to the suggestion of the Court,

IT IS ORDERED that the date for filing responses to bench memorandum shall be the Monday after the filing of such memorandum unless the Court otherwise sets an earlier date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any and all responses to City of Flagstaff's memorandum shall be due no later than **Monday, September 21, 2020**.

Ms. Ransom reports that the City of Flagstaff is working with the Hopi Tribe on its proposed redactions to the past and present exhibits of the Hopi Tribe. The parties will deal with any remaining issues on September 29, 2020 when the Hopi Tribe begins its case.
