The Hopi Tribe and the United States have each filed status reports regarding their respective work to amend their statements of claimant for off-reservation Hopi Water Rights. Counsel for the Hopi Tribe asserted the “extreme importance of adopting procedures for the summary adjudication of *de minimis* water uses” and the possibility of the Hopi Tribe’s being “prejudiced by further delays in the adoption of summary procedures to adjudicate *de minimis* uses.” The Hopi Tribe’s Status Report on Amending Statements of Claimant For Off-Reservation Lands, dated June 16, 2017, pp. 4, 5.
