ORDER INITIATING CONTESTED CASE

CONTESTED CASE NAME: In re Luebbermann.

HSR INVOLVED: San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report.

DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: The Special Master initiates a contested case to address objections to watershed file report 115-04-ADA-002 and sets a Scheduling Conference.

NUMBER OF PAGES: 10.

DATE OF FILING: July 3, 2017.

This Order initiates a contested case to resolve objections to watershed file report 115-04-ADA-002 that sets forth water rights proposed by Arizona Department of Water Resources to Aravaipa Creek for domestic and irrigation use. This contested case involves four statements of claimant: 39-603, 39-4073, 39-11675, and 39-11676. Each statement of claim was assigned to Henri A. and Susan E. Luebbermann in 1988. In connection with that assignment process, the records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources include

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Notices of Valuation the Pinal County Assessor issued for three tax parcels: 300-57-002 2; 300-57-004; and 300-57-003 1. Mr. and Mrs. Luebbermann subsequently transferred the property in 2002 and 2006. The public records maintained by the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain an assignment of claims for water rights from Henri A. and Susan E. Luebbermann.

This case is designed to determine water rights; it is not a case to determine property ownership or property rights. Accordingly the information provided above shall not be considered a finding of property ownership or property rights.

In 1991, the Arizona Department of Water Resources issued Watershed File Report 115-04-ADA-002 as part of the San Pedro Hydrographic Survey Report. It identified the point of diversion of surface water from Aravaipa Creek as NESWSW Sec. 26 T6S R17E. It proposed four water rights under the heading "PWR Summary": one water right for domestic use on the SW Sec. 26 T6S R17E and three water rights for irrigation use on the NWSW & SWSW Sec. 26 T6S R17E. A copy of the watershed file report is attached as Appendix A. Objection were filed by the claimant and those entities listed on Appendix B.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. <u>Contested Case Designation and Docket Number</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Luebbermann* and it will address the claims for water rights analyzed in

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and the objections that were filed to the watershed file report 115-04-ADA-002 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991).

2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the claimants of record, i.e., Henri A. and Susan E. Luebbermann, and all persons who filed objections to watershed file report 115-04-ADA-002 listed on Appendix B, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Appendix B of this order as well as Janet Miller for the Arizona Department of Water Resources. A courtesy copy of this Order shall be sent to Tracy Gaudet, Stephen Turcotte and Jane Stevens, Trustees of the Turcotte Family Trust, and David Rychener and Joyce H. - B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.

5. <u>Scheduling Conference</u>. Pursuant to §8.03[1], Rules for Proceedings before the Special Master, a scheduling conference shall be held to address the adjudication of this case, a schedule to identify issues, file disclosure statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and set a trial date, if needed.
