On January 4, 2019, the United States filed a Notice of Lapse in Appropriations and Request for Stay of existing deadlines with the proposition that when Congress appropriates funding for the Department of Justice and Interior, new deadlines will be set. While, in general,

1 the United States' approach is reasonable given the circumstances, at this point it does not appear
2 necessary to stay all deadlines currently scheduled through 2022 or stay all deadlines for all parties.

3 Thus, only the following deadlines will be stayed or vacated as specifically listed:

6 (a) The deadline for the United States' briefing on the *De Minimis* issue is stayed.

7 All of the remaining parties are expected to file their briefs on January 22, 2019.

8 (b) The deadline for filing responses to the briefs set for February 12, 2019 is stayed
9 and the oral argument scheduled for February 21, 2019 is vacated.
