Report 113-12-BA-012 identifies one potential water right for irrigation use in Section 23 T11S R18E. In addition, pursuant to A.R.S. § 45-257, which requires that a "claimant's small water use claims¹ shall be determined in conjunction with the determination of that claimant's other claims," this contested case shall also resolve objections to claims for stock watering identified in Watershed File Report 113-11-002 that lists two potential water rights for stock watering in sections 14 and 24 in T12S R17E. Copies of the watershed file reports are included as Attachment A.

The Arizona Department of Water Resources identified Riley West, Inc. as the land owner in Watershed File Report 113-11-002. Riley West, Inc. filed Statement of Claimant (SOC) 39-2080. In 1999, Riley West, Inc. assigned SOC 39-2080 to The Nature Conservancy which assigned the SOC to Pima County Regional Flood Control District on September 22, 2011. Based on the records maintained by the Pima County Assessor, the Pima County Regional Flood Control District owns the land on which potential water right 113-11-002-SW001 is used. It also owns land in Section 24 T12S R17E (Tax Parcel 205-23-003D), but the Bellota Preservation Corporation, an Arizona corporation, owns the land (Tax Parcel 205-23-003E) actually included in the legal description for potential water right 113-11-002-SW002. The public records maintained by the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not include a statement of claimant filed by Bellota Preservation Corporation.

The expedited process established in the Memorandum Decision, Findings of Fact, and Conclusions of Law for Group 1 Cases involving Stockwatering, Stockponds, and Domestic Uses, dated November 14, 1994, amended February 23, 1995, approved and

modified September 27, 2002 ("Decision") shall be used to prepare proposed water right abstracts for stock watering claims upon a showing that appropriate claims have been filed.

# IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. <u>Contested Cases, Consolidation, Designation and Docket Number</u>. This contested case initiates case nos. W1-11-2645 and W1-11-2690. These two cases are consolidated under *In re Pima County Flood Control District*, Contested Case No. W1-11-2690.
- 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The parties in this contested case are the Pima County Flood Control District, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are listed on Attachment B, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.
