It also filed six proposed abstracts. No 23 other proposed corrections have been filed. 24 Five of the proposed abstracts stem from water rights analyzed in Watershed File Report 25 111-19-002. Pima County suggested an addition to one legal description for a stockpond right 26 27

which was confirmed by a Field Inspection Report associated with Stockpond Claim No. 38-81495, which also provided GPS coordinates. The five proposed water rights are as follows:
