The purpose of the status conference is to determine the landowners who are asserting claims to water diverted from the Pomerene Canal for irrigation uses. Landowners must file a Statement of Claimant with the Arizona Department of Water Resources, obtain an assignment of an existing Statement of Claimant, or have a Statement of Claimant filed on his or her behalf. Currently, the attorney for the board of Pomerene Water Users Association is in the process of identifying those landowners on whose behalf the Pomerene Water Users Association will file claims for water rights.

In addition, as stated in this Court's Order filed January 24, 2018, consideration will be given at the status conference to two watershed file reports, 112-17-BAA-208 and 112-17-BAA-209, that identify claims for water use for which no current landowner has apparently filed a statement of claimant, an assignment of an existing statement of claimant or indicated that their interests would be represented by Pomerene Water Users Association. As to all other watershed file reports included in this case, at least one landowner has either filed a statement of claimant or Pomerene Water Users Association has indicated that it would be representing the interests of at least one landowner who owns land included in the watershed file report. Based on county records, the current landowners of the land included in watershed file reports 112-17-BAA-208 and 112-17-BAA-209 are:
