17 DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: This order sets a deadline for a joint status report from the
18 property owner David Jackson and the Arizona Department of Water Resources no later
than **January 6, 2026**.

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21 On September 12, 2025, the Special Master received a status report from the
22 Arizona Adjudications Project ("Project"), counsel for property owner David Jackson.
23 As part of the status report, the Project requested guidance regarding when Mr. Jackson
24 should file an amendment to his Statement of Claimant #39-1721 ("the SOC"). Mr.
25 Jackson intends to amend the SOC to cite stockpond registration #38-18383 as basis of
26 right.

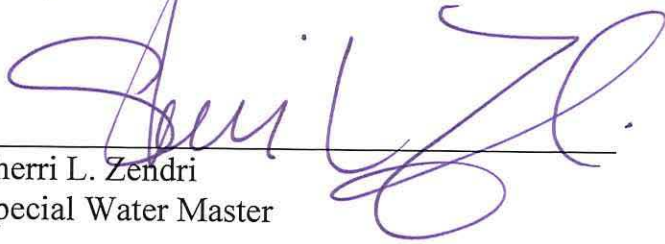
27 In a September 16, 2025, order, the Special Master determined that a stockpond
28 registration must be certified to serve as a basis of right. Whether a claimant should wait

1 until a stockpond registration is certified before incorporating it into an SOC is best
2 determined by the claimant and their attorney based upon their individual circumstances.
3 Claimants should note, however, that results of the certification process may necessitate
4 revisions to the SOC.

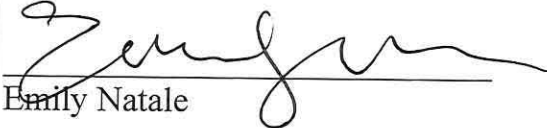
5 **IT IS ORDERED** that Mr. Jackson and the Arizona Department of Water
6 Resources ("ADWR") shall provide a joint status update to the Court regarding the
7 progress for certification of stockpond #38-18383 by **January 6, 2026**. If ADWR cannot
8 provide a completion date, ADWR shall file a status report with the Special Master every
9 three months until such a date can be provided.

10 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that due to new court technology, all future filings
11 use the case number in the format as shown above.
