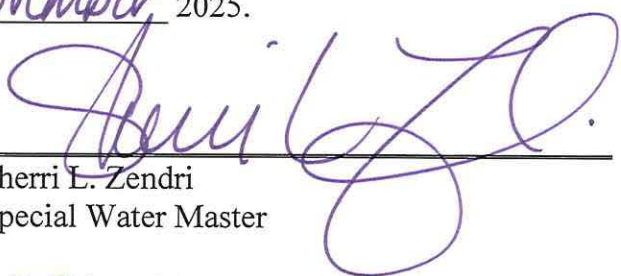

28 IBLI Order] that appear extraneous to their associated abstract.” IBLI Order at 13. The

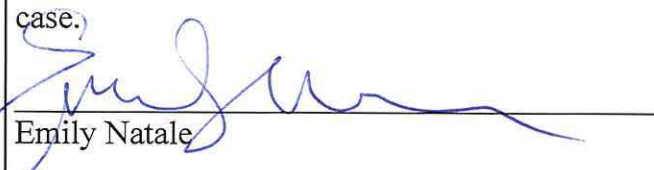
1 Plan filed by ADWR includes a list of nearly 100 abstracts that may have extraneous
2 stockpond registration certification applications. However, many of the “extraneous”
3 application numbers listed are the very numbers listed as the basis of right on the
4 abstracts in question.
