Avechuco file written notice with the Court no later than **February 28, 2026**, to confirm he is interested in continuing to pursue whatever water rights he may have on his property. Should Mr. Avechuco fail to respond to this Court order, his statement of claimant #39-0003139 will be dismissed and no further action will be taken in this case.

There is no objection from the parties.

The Court thanks Jose Garcia Fonseca, the court-appointed Spanish interpreter, and relieves him of his duties for today's hearing.
