STATUS CONFERENCE

On April 23, 2026, Claimant Scott Nolen filed an explanation for failing to confer with the Arizona Department of Water Resources (“ADWR”), a status of his claims, and a request for a status conference to “go over the paperwork and ensure it is properly completed to the satisfaction of ADWR Adjudications, ADWR Surface Water permitting, and the Special Water Master.”

IT IS ORDERED setting a virtual status conference for **Thursday, June 4, 2026, at 11:00 am.**

Mr. Nolen is reminded that neither ADWR nor any court personnel can provide him with legal advice. However, general information about the adjudication process,


1 what information ADWR or the Special Master is looking to capture, or the meaning of

4 **STATEMENTS OF CLAIMANT**

5 The watershed file report (“WFR”) for this contested case, #113-09-CC-092,
6 includes 6 statements of claimant (“SOCs”). The April 23, 2026, filing confirms SOCs
7 39-6039 and 39-12300 will not be pursued. It is understood SOC 39-12300 will no longer
8 be pursued because well 55-804807 is not located on Mr. Nolen’s property. However,
9 filings for SOC 39-12302 also indicate the use of well 55-804807, therefore the status of
10 39-12302 is unclear. The April 23, 2026, filing does not address SOC 39-12299.
11 Attachment A is a table summarizing the Special Master’s understanding of what claims
12 Mr. Nolen intends to pursue.


