DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: The Arizona State Land Department shall, by **February 20, 2026**, either secure assignments of former lessees' application or file notice with the Court.

The Arizona State Land Department (“ASLD”) timely notified the Court on December 11, 2025, that through discussions with the Arizona Department of Water Resources (“ADWR”) both agencies noted that in addition to the stockpond registrations act (“SPRA”) filings for stockponds included in this contested case filed by ASLD, there are SPRA filings for stockponds included in this contested case that have been filed by prior lessees. ASLD requests time to either secure an assignment of the former lessees’ applications or file a motion with the Court, after which ADWR could process the

1 appropriate applications and proceed to stockpond certification.

2 **IT IS ORDERED** that ASLD shall, by **February 20, 2026**, either secure
3 assignments of former lessees' application or file a motion with the Court that permits
4 ADWR to process the appropriate applications and proceed to stockpond certification
