On November 17, 2025, the United States of America (“United States”) filed a “Notice of Resumptions of Federal Appropriations and Operations” (“Notice”), informing the Court that the United States is able to resume participation in Arizona General Stream Adjudication proceedings. Therefore,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that email copies of the Replies must be provided to the Office of the Special Master by the filing deadline.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that oral arguments for all the dispositive motions will occur REMOTELY via Court Connect on **December 11, 2025, at 10:00 am.** Each party will be allotted 20 minutes of total speaking time. Parties may reserve as much of that time as desired for rebuttal. ASARCO will be permitted to speak first. Objectors will speak in the following order:

1. United States
2. San Carlos Apache Tribe
3. Gila River Indian Community
4. Salt River Project


No general opening statements will be needed; parties can assume all motions, responses, and replies have been read. Only parties who filed motions, responses, or replies will be permitted to present oral arguments.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the remaining trial deadlines will be discussed and determined after oral argument.
