In a Minute Entry issued in this case on October 11, 2021, the Court ordered that Arizona Department of Water Resources (“ADWR”) file a map defining the relationship of the well registered under Jack and Nina L. Williams, registration no. 55-809290, and the subflow zone. The Minute Entry stated that if the well was located outside the boundaries of the subflow zone and Mr. Williams had filed a Statement of Claimant, the Court would stay this case until ADWR completes the subflow depletion test.

1 On November 2, 2021, ADWR filed a map that confirms the well is outside of the subflow
2 zone. Additionally, Mr. Williams has filed a Statement of Claimant with ADWR for this
3 potential water right. Accordingly, the determination of any such right must be stayed until the
4 approval of the subflow depletion test.

5 **IT IS ORDERED** that this case is stayed
