Discussion is held. ADWR found that the water on the property is provided by a water company. Mr. Miller states that he intends to pursue a water right and file a Statement of Claimant. He believes the well used for irrigation on the property is registered under either his or Brandy Harper's name.

Based on the forgoing,

IT IS ORDERED that ADWR shall file a map defining the relationship of the well and the subflow zone by **November 8, 2021**. If the well is outside the boundaries of the subflow zone and Mr. Miller has filed a Statement of Claimant, the Court will stay this case until ADWR completes the tests necessary for the continuation of the case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED adding Mark McGinnis on behalf of Salt River Project to the Court-approved mailing list in this case.

LATER: Based on the public records of ADWR, a well located in Section 12 Township 23S Range 20E is registered to Brandy Harper and Brandon Miller as 55-601393. Arizona Department of Water Resources shall provide a map of the location of the well and the boundary of the subflow zone. If the well is located outside the boundary of the subflow zone, ADWR shall include on the map the distance between the well and the subflow zone.
