In a Minute Entry issued in this case on October 11, 2021, the Court ordered that Arizona Department of Water Resources (“ADWR”) file a map defining the relationship of the well registered under Brandy Harper and Brandon Miller, registration no. 55-601393, and the subflow zone. The Minute Entry stated that if the well was located outside the boundaries of the subflow zone and Brandon Miller had filed a Statement of Claimant, the Court would stay this case until ADWR competes the subflow depletion test.

1 On November 2, 2021, ADWR filed a map that confirms the well is outside of the subflow  
2 zone. Additionally, Brandy Harper and Brandon Miller have filed a Statement of Claimant with  
3 ADWR for this potential water right. Accordingly, the determination of any such right must be  
4 stayed until the approval of the subflow depletion test.

5 **IT IS ORDERED** that this case is stayed
