General Explanation

This Order begins the process necessary to adjudicate claims for rights to appropriable water for land that the Cochise County Assessor has identified as owned by: Canyon Creek Properties, Joan Wuester, Michael and Patricia Hammerschmidt, Javier and Janet Cornejo, and Edwin Ulanday. This contested case is one of the many cases in the General Stream Adjudication

for the San Pedro River watershed to determine legal rights to water. Other cases in which claims have been made to water in the San Pedro River watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting initiation. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who filed statement of claimants for rights to use appropriable water in the San Pedro River Watershed. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria, and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

In this case, Cedric G. Rameriz ("Claimant") filed a Statement of Claimant on July 13, 1984 for rights to use water for domestic and irrigation purposes on land on three acres in Section 18 Township 23S Range 21E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated those claims and prepared a report known as Watershed File Report No. 111-23-DBB-027("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared by Arizona Department of Water Resources of the land investigated is attached as Attachment B.

The WFR lists potential water rights for domestic and irrigation uses of water on the land, and identified surface water as the source of water for the irrigation use. After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims made for water rights that are the subject of the WFR and resolve the objections to the WFR.

Claimant & Landowners

The WFR identified one Statement of Claimant (SOC) relevant to the potential water right: 39-0655. Cedric G. Martinez filed the SOC claiming water for irrigation and domestic uses from a creek in the San Pedro watershed. On March 18, 1989, Sally Martinez filed amended Statements of Claimant 39-0655 that reported the death of Cedric Martinez and claimed water

rights for domestic, irrigation, and other uses from an instream pump. The public records maintained by the ADWR do not include an assignment of the SOC or amended SOCs.

The WFR lists Cedric G. and Sally G. Martinez as the owners of the property described in the WFR. The records of the Cochise County Assessor identify Canyon Creek Properties, Joan Wuester, Michael and Patricia Hammerschmidt, Javier and Janet Cornejo, and Edwin Ulanday as the owners of the property described in the WFR. A copy of a map prepared by the Cochise County Assessor is attached as Attachment C. The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not include a Statement of Claimant filed by Canyon Creek Properties, Joan Wuester, Michael and Patricia Hammerschmidt, Javier and Janet Cornejo, or Edwin Ulanday.

IT IS ORDERED:

- Contested Case. This contested case shall be known as In re Cedric and Sally G. 1. Martinez and it will determine appropriable water rights asserted in the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 111-23-DBB-027 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case and name number the on following website: http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew. asp
- 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are Sally G. Martinez, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the WFR, who are included on Attachment C, and parties who are allowed to intervene by order.

Court-Approved Mailing List.

A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified

only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Courtapproved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.

- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County

 Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the

 Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list.

 Upon request, the Clerk of the Court will provide copies by email. Parties may request emailed copies of minute entries and orders by completing and submitting a CONSENT FOR ELECTRONIC RECEIPT OF WATER CASE DOCUMENTS, which is attached as Attachment E.

4. <u>Status Conference.</u>

A. An initial status conference shall be held to determine whether the Claimant, Canyon Creek Properties, Joan Wuester, Michael and Patricia Hammerschmidt, Javier and Janet Cornejo, or Edwin Ulanday intend to pursue claims for rights to appropriable water. If so, the parties seeking water rights shall be prepared at the Status Conference to provide information about efforts undertaken to assign or file a Statement of Claimant.

B. If the Claimant or current landowners intend to pursue rights to appropriable water for use on the land, the parties will be expected to advise whether they are interested in pursuing discussions to resolve the objections to the WFR and the amount of time that the parties believe will be necessary to complete those discussions.

C. If the objections cannot be settled, then a subsequent date will be set for a scheduling conference to identify issues, file disclosure statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. No party shall conduct any discovery or file any motions prior to the Status Conference.

The Status Conference shall be held on **November 19, 2021 at 3:00 p.m**. The Status Conference shall be held using the Court Connect program. 


