Mr. Cooper states that as noted in the Court's minute entry of May 20, 2022, there were two matters to come before the Town of Mammoth and the San Carlos Apache Tribe regarding a stipulation. The Stipulation was approved by the Town of Mammoth on May 17, 2022. Mr. Sparks intended to present the Stipulation to the Tribal Counsel (San Carlos Apache Tribe) a few days ago.

Mr. Sparks states that the meeting was very long lasting over 12 hours. The Tribal Counsel is set to discuss the Stipulation on June 16, 2022. Mr. Sparks states that he has recommended to the Tribal Counsel that it be approved and believes that it will be approved on June 16, 2022.

Mr. Sparks will file either the signed Stipulation or file a Status Report if the Stipulation was not approved, for the Court by not later than **June 20, 2022** regarding this issue.
