Discussion is held regarding the status report filed by counsel for Resolution Copper Mining. Mr. LeMaster states that there is no time frame for resolution of this matter between the United States and the various surrounding tribes. Mr. Sparks states that he is aware of the lawsuit but is not directly involved and has no idea about time

frames.

The Court will not grant an indefinite stay in this matter.

1:35 p.m. R. Lee Leininger is present for U.S. Department of Justice, Environment and Natural Resources Division. Mr. Leininger concurs with John LeMaster's response and further updates the Court. He states also that the request for the stay is not a permanent stay and that he will continue to update the Court regarding the progress of the exchange and the outcome of the pending lawsuits.

The Court will set another status conference for late summer or early fall in this matter and suggests that Mr. Leininger meet and confer with Mr. LeMaster to see how the United States could become more involved in the case so it can proceed forward. This case is one of nine irrigation cases that is holding up close to 1,000 cases for claims for water rights for domestic and stock watering uses and stockponds in the subwater shed.

Based on the matters discussed on the record,

IT IS ORDERED granting the U.S. Department of Justice's request for a stay.

Mr. LeMaster states that he will further discuss the matter with his client.
