DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: This order sets a deadline of **Monday**, **June 30**, **2025**, for Mr. Buzan to file all required documents and a deadline of **July 14**, **2025**, to provide notice of actions to the Court.

This contested case was initiated on November 25, 2024. During the initial status conference, property owner Robert Allen Buzan Jr. indicated he was interested in pursuing potential water rights; however, Mr. Buzan did not attend the March 6, 2025, status conference. In response to an order from the Special Master filed in the minute entry from the March 6, 2025, status conference, Mr. Buzan indicated he does wish to pursue any potential water rights. It is unclear if the letter from Mr. Buzan was properly filed and shared with all parties on the Court-approved mailing list therefore it is included with this order as Attachment I.

To pursue water rights, a property owner must **both** file a Statement of Claimant ("SOC"), and present to the Court evidence of a legal right to the water they claimed on

the SOC, also called a "basis of right." There is currently no basis of right documents associated with this contested case. Based upon the current information, the following options are available to establish an appropriate basis of right:

- A. Submit to the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") a "Claim of Water Right for a Stockpond and Application for Certification" if the pond meets ALL the following requirements:
 - 1. Less than or equal to fifteen acre-feet in volume.
 - 2. Constructed before 1977.
 - 3. Used solely for watering livestock or wildlife.
 - 4. Not used primarily for fishing or culturing of fish.
- **B.** For water uses that do not meet the stockpond definition, file an application for permit to appropriate water. Please note that the priority date for a permit filing is the date the application is received by ADWR.

IT IS ORDERED that if Mr. Buzan intends to pursue potential water rights he must file by June 30, 2025, an SOC for stockpond use, and for domestic use if applicable, and appropriate basis of right documentation to substantiate his SOC claims.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Buzan shall ensure his well is properly registered with ADWR and file notice with the Court no later than July 14, 2025, indicating the well is registered and that all documentation required by June 30th was provided to ADWR.

Mr. Buzan is encouraged to contact ADWR for general information and guidance regarding the appropriate application forms. Please note that ADWR staff cannot provide legal advice.
