This case involves *de minimis* claims for water rights analyzed by Watershed File Report 113-12-010 included in the final hydrographic survey report for the San Pedro Watershed ("San Pedro HSR") filed on November 20, 1991. In 1994, the Special Master issued


1 a Memorandum Decision, Findings of Fact, and Conclusions of Law for Group 1 Cases
2 involving Stockwatering, Stockponds, and Domestic Uses, dated November 14, 1994, amended
3 February 23, 1995, approved and modified September 27, 2002 ("Decision"). The Decision
4 established the procedures for adjudicating *de minimis* water rights for claims in the San Pedro
5 watershed.

6 After the proposed water right abstracts have been prepared, "the litigants will be
7 provided an opportunity to suggest the correction of mistakes in the proposed abstracts."
8 Decision, p. 47. Once the clerical corrections have been completed, the abstracts will be
9 included in a catalog of proposed water rights where they will be subject to very limited set of
10 objections and ultimately included in a final decree. As required by the Decision, proposed
11 water right abstracts have been prepared for the *de minimis* water rights analyzed by Watershed
12 File Report no. 113-12-010 for which Arizona Department of Water Resources identified
13 applicable pre-filing documents. The proposed abstracts are attached as Appendix A.

14 **IT IS ORDERED** that any suggested corrections to the proposed abstracts shall be filed
15 on or before **November 2, 2021**.

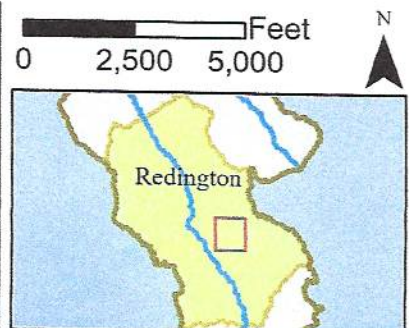
