
21 On December 4, 2024, the Special Master ordered a six-month stay of the  
22 proceedings in this contested case pending resolution of other cases regarding  
23 whether changes in the point of diversion for a water right affects the priority date  
24 of that right. As of the date of this order, those cases have not yet been resolved.

25 **IT IS ORDERED** continuing the stay of this matter until the resolution of  
26 the issue regarding changes in point of diversion from surface water to a well.

27 Additionally, on July 30, 2025, the Office of the Special Master received a  
28 letter from Donna Quisenberry, a current property owner in this contested case,

1 regarding the potential aluminum recycling facility Aluminum Dynamics. It  
2 appears this letter was copied to all parties on the Court-Approved Mailing List for  
3 this contested case. Notwithstanding the fact that Mrs. Quisenberry's letter did not  
4 ask the court for any type of relief, the Aluminum Dynamics facility is not a party  
5 to this contested case and this court has no jurisdiction with respect to the zoning  
6 or air quality permitting noted in the letter. Mrs. Quisenberry's letter is  
7 acknowledged as being received by the Court, however no action can be taken.
