The Court notes that it did not receive a joint schedule. Counsel Leavitt indicates that they are pivoting to pre-1919 continuous use claim and forgoing the subflow claim. The Court does not have a Statement of Claimant from the Heartquists and will need one filed in their name.

Counsel Leavitt has obtained an assignment from ADWR and will file an Amended Statement of Claim by the middle of next week. There is documentation for the pre-1919 water right.

Discussion is held. Counsel Sparks states that their office has not received anything from Counsel Leavitt or the Heartquists. Counsel Leavitt is directed to include the filings with his status report so the parties all have a copy.

Based on the discussion held,

IT IS ORDERED that Counsel Leavitt file an Amended Statement of Claim by May 9, 2025.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Counsel Leavitt file a Status Report by July 11, 2025. Counsel Leavitt shall confer with ADWR prior to filing the report and include their anticipated timeframe for processing. The Status Report shall also include confirmation of the basis of right, how the Heartquists intend to handle the objections as well as copies of the filings.

LET THE RECORD REFLECT that Counsel Leavitt will also email Counsel Nielsen once the Amended Statement of Claimant is filed so she can notify staff to get it online for the objectors to review.

Once the Court receives the July Status Report a separate order will be issued regarding the next steps.
