DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: The Special Master grants the Joint Stipulation and Motion for a Protective Order by the Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District and the Salt River Valley Water Users' Association and Freeport McMoRan Corporation, and hereby enters this Protective Order, limiting the use and dissemination of documents subject to the Order.

Upon consideration of the Joint Stipulation and Motion for Protective Order of the Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District and the Salt River Valley Water Users' Association, Freeport McMoRan Corporation, and Dr. peter N. Reinthal (collectively, the "Parties"), and pursuant to Arizona Rule of Civil Procedure 26(c), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1 1. “Confidential Material,” as used herein, shall mean any information,
2 documentation, records or reports that Dr. Reinthal produces in response to the March 1, 2013
3 subpoena issued by this Court, concerning his research on aquatic resources related to
4 Aravaipa Canyon or Aravaipa Creek.

5 2. Confidential Material produced by Dr. Reinthal shall be disclosed only to the
6 Parties’ counsel, experts, and representatives directly involved in this litigation.

7 3. All Confidential Material shall be used only for purposes of this litigation. The
8 Parties will maintain control over all copies of the Confidential Material and will not make
9 additional copies of or distribute the Confidential Material except for bona fide purposes of
10 this action. All such copies of the Confidential Material will be subject to this Protective
11 Order.

12 4. This Protective Order is binding upon the Parties, their attorneys, agents, and all
13 persons under their control. It is the responsibility of the attorneys of record to advise the
14 Parties, members and employees of their law firms, consultants, experts and witnesses to
15 whom they may reveal Confidential Material of this Protective Order.

16 6. The Court may impose sanctions on any person using the Confidential Material
17 for any purpose other than as provided in this Protective Order, or who otherwise violates the
18 provisions of this Protective Order.
