ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR AMENDED STATEMENTS OF **CLAIMANT AND INTERIM** STATUS REPORTS

CONTESTED CASE NAME: *In re Hopi Tribe Priority*.

HSR INVOLVED: None.

DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: Amended statements of claimant for water rights appurtenant to land owned by or in trust for the Hopi Tribe located outside the boundaries of the 1882 Reservation and Moenkopi Island shall be filed by December 15, 2017, and periodic status reports shall be submitted to the court.

DATE OF FILING: August 3, 2016.

On July 12, 2016, a status conference was held to consider the process to adjudicate water rights appurtenant to that real property located outside the Hopi Reservation, the boundaries of which are defined in the Hopi I HSR, and owned by the Hopi Tribe or held in trust for the Hopi Tribe by the United States. The United States and the Hopi Tribe identified the off-reservation land as: the Hopi Ranches, i.e., the Aja,

Clear Creek, DoBell, Drye, Hart and 26 Bar Ranches and the land acquired by or on behalf of the Hopi Tribe adjacent to the named ranches, Hopi Industrial Park, Homolovi Lands, Stockhausen Land Donation, Twin Arrows Property and four commercial properties. The Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) specified the information to be provided by the Hopi Tribe and the United States in the amended statements of claimant that will expedite its analysis of the claimed water rights. The Hopi Tribe has also requested that as part of the process, ADWR should analyze all statements of claimant filed by its predecessors in interest to the off-reservation land.

At the status conference, consideration was given to the possible identification and resolution of legal issues during the period prior to the filing of the amended statements of claimant. Several parties submitted a list of issues. Other parties argued that the resolution of dispositive issues should await the completion of discovery presumably after a final HSR is completed. It appears from the very brief descriptions of the issues provided by the parties that the issues will depend, at a minimum, upon the actual water rights claimed by the Hopi Tribe and the United States in the amended statements of claimant. Accordingly, no briefing schedule will be set at this time. If, however, one or more parties believe that the process can be advanced by a summary judgment motion, such party may file a motion at such time as the party deems appropriate and it will be considered along with any responses and replies timely filed in accordance with the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure.

Finally, the parties offered multiple suggestions for the geographical scope of the Hopi II HSR ranging from the entire Coronado Aquifer (C Aquifer) to only the claims

listed in the amended statements of claimant. This decision will be deferred until such time as more information becomes available.

IT IS ORDERED that the Hopi Tribe and the United States shall file a report by October 28, 2016, listing the statements of claimant filed by their predecessors in interest that have not been assigned to the United States or the Hopi Tribe and identifying the reasons that such statements of claimant should not be dismissed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Hopi Tribe and the United States shall file by December 15, 2017, amended statements of claimant for the Hopi Industrial Park and such other off-reservation land for which no claims are made for irrigation, stockponds or stock watering that contain the following information:

- Information about historic and existing types of water uses on the Hopi
  Industrial Park and such other off-reservation land;
- 2. Current quantities of use and the method of measuring or estimating such quantities;
- 3. Sources of water;
- 4. Dates on which water uses began and supporting documentation or imagery; and
- 5. A map provided in a digital ArcGIS format (i.e., geodatabase, map coverages or feature classes, and/or polygon or point shapefile data) that shows the places of use, points of diversion, and the boundaries of the Hopi Industrial Park and such other off-reservation land.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Hopi Tribe and the United States shall file by December 15, 2017, amended statements of claimant for the Hopi Ranches and such other off-reservation land for which a claim is made for irrigation, stockponds or stock watering that contain the following information:

- 1. Updated water right abstracts, as appropriate, with new filings, if any;
- 2. Current quantities of use and the method of measuring or estimating such quantities; and
- 3. Documents or imagery to support the priority dates claimed in the water right abstracts.
- 4. For irrigation uses:
  - a. Mapped locations of currently irrigated acres and acreage totals;
  - b. Names and locations of diversions/sources for both groundwater and surface water;
  - c. Annual volume used; and
  - d. Basis for determining the annual volume used:
    - i. Diversion measurements
    - ii. Crop types and consumptive use for each crop
    - iii. Estimated conveyance efficiencies
    - iv. Estimated on-farm efficiencies
    - v. Fill capacities of water storage facilities
    - vi. Evaporation losses from any water storage facilities

- 5. For stockpond uses:
  - a. Stockpond capacities and the method of measurement; and
  - b. Basis for determining the annual volume used.
- 6. For stock watering other than from a stockpond and for domestic uses, the basis for determining the annual volume used.
- 7. A map provided in a digital ArcGIS format (i.e., geodatabase, map coverages or feature classes, and/ or polygon or point shapefile data) that shows the places of use, points of diversion, and the boundaries of the ranch properties, including all state and federal leased land, and such other off-reservation land.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Hopi Tribe and the United States shall file a status report on December 16, 2016, and on June 16, 2017, describing the work completed and the work in progress with respect to the amended statements of claimant.
