2:05 p.m. This is the time set for an initial permissible ex-parte hearing concerning the application of the Settling Parties to consider the Amended and Restated White Mountain Apache Tribe Water Rights Quantification Agreement dated as of November 1, 2012 ("WMAT Agreement"). In the courtroom are: Robert C. Brauchli on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; Cynthia S. Campbell on behalf of the City of Phoenix; Christopher W. Payne on behalf of the Roosevelt Water Conservation District; Cynthia J. Haglin on behalf of the City of Chandler; William H. Anger on behalf of the cities of Avondale, Chandler, Glendale, Mesa and Scottsdale; Janet L. Miller and Nicole D. Klobas on behalf of the Arizona Department Water Resources; and Lisa M. McKnight, John B. Weldon, Jr., and Patrick B. Sigl on behalf of the Salt River Project.

A record of the proceedings is made by audio and/or videotape in lieu of a court reporter.

Mr. Brauchli makes a presentation of substance and scope of the WMAT Agreement.

The Court finds it is appropriate to commence special proceedings regarding approval of the WMAT Agreement in accordance with the applicable orders of the Arizona Supreme Court entered in both adjudications.

IT IS ORDERED directing the Arizona Department Water Resources to prepare a factual analysis and technical assessment of the WMAT Agreement to be submitted no later than **Friday, July 25, 2014.**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Settling Parties shall submit revised orders for special proceedings to the Court with the appropriate administrative information that needs to be completed.
