- Need to resolve an outstanding warrant?
- Need to get your driver's license reinstated?
- Want to resolve barriers to housing and employment?

Process

- ◆ A **Provider** submits your application to MCRHC, once you meet their criteria.
- ◆ You attend court without fear of being arrested.
- ◆ MCRHC is held at the **Lodestar Day Resource Center**.
- ◆ Your cases are combined and heard at one time.
- ◆ Your case manager accompanies you to court to discuss your progress, accomplishments and community restitution hours.
- ◆ Fines are resolved through community restitution. One (1) hour resolves \$10 in fines.

Eligibility

Homeless Court hears victimless, misdemeanor offenses from any Municipal or Justice of the Peace Court in Maricopa County.

- ◆ Typical offenses include: parking, traffic, loitering, trespassing and 'quality of life' offenses.
- ◆ No felonies within the last 10 years, except for drug and/or DUI convictions.
