Whereas the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent need for qualified English<>Tojolabal court interpreter owing to demand for interpretation services in Mexican indigenous languages and lack of availability of current contractors;

Whereas the existing court interpreter vendors do not have qualified and reliable Tojolabal language interpreters;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing interpretation to the trial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of qualified providers. This action will avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring English<>Tojolabal interpretation services.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Ms. Mary Jill Brody, a professor at Louisiana State University, be allowed to work as an English<>Tojolabal contract court interpreter during the period February 2, 2007 and June 30, 2007.
2. Ms. Mary Jill Brody be compensated at the rate of \$100 per hour or \$800 per day. The Court will pay for all travel, lodging, and ground transportation expenses. In addition, the Court will pay a per diem of up to \$50 per day, provided that receipts are submitted with the invoice.
3. Ms. Mary Jill Brody be exempt from providing proof of liability and professional insurance.
4. Ms. Mary Jill Brody abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for Court Interpreters established by this Court.
