PRISON RAPE ELIMINATION ACT

PREA is a Federal Law requiring the elimination and prevention of sexual assault, harassment and rape in correctional settings. Consensual sex in a correctional setting is also unlawful; therefore all sexual behavior (physical and verbal) is considered a violation of the Zero Tolerance Policy as defined by the PREA Standards.. All sexual acts, inappropriate touching and comments, indecent exposure, invasion of privacy, sexual harassment and sexual assault will not be tolerated. Maricopa County Juvenile Probation Department is committed to providing an environment where detained youth are safe from harm.

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

Maricopa County Juvenile Probation Department will not tolerate sexual assault, rape, inappropriate comments, touching, sexual harassment, indecent exposure, inappropriate invasion of privacy, obscene language or gestures. This policy applies to all MCJPD employees including education, medical and mental health professionals, contract workers, religious personnel, volunteers, detained youth and all visitors. Under the law, detained youth are unable to give consent to a romantic or sexual relationship with anyone they meet in a correctional setting. This law applies even if the youth is old enough to give consent in other settings outside of confinement. Inappropriate relationships between a youth and an MCJPD employee will not be tolerated and is also unacceptable once the youth is released from detention.

THIRD PARTY REPORTING

If you are visiting this facility as a parent, counselor, therapist, advocate or in any other capacity, you may report any alleged sexual abuse or sexual harassment on behalf of any detained youth. If you are a parent or guardian you can file a grievance or make an appeal without the youth's permission.

- ◆ MCJPD has a Zero Tolerance Policy for Sexual Abuse, Sexual Assault and Sexual Harassment.
- ◆ Every report will be investigated
- ◆ We will protect youth against retaliation.

REPORT ALLEGED ABUSE OR HARASSMENT BY:

- ◆ Completing a Third Party Reporting Form.
- ◆ Contacting the PREA Coordinator or PREA Compliance Manager (information on back page).
- ◆ Requesting to speak with the Supervisor on duty.
- ◆ Calling the facility where the alleged incident happened.
- ◆ Submitting a written statement to the facility where the alleged incident happened.
