On July 5, 2017, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution, the Arizona Supreme Court ordered that Supreme Court Administrative Rule V-A was repealed and replaced by the provisions of Administrative Order 2017-79 entitled "Presiding Judge of the County." Those provisions contain amendments based on the August 12, 2016 Fair Justice for All Task Force's recommendations.

The Arizona Supreme Court further ordered that Supreme Court Administrative Rule VII-A was repealed and replaced by the attached provisions of Administrative Order 2017-79 entitled "Presiding Judge - Municipal Court." Those provisions also contain amendments based on the Fair Justice for All Task Force's recommendations.

One of the effects of Supreme Court Administrative Order 2017-79 was the elimination of Uniform Bond Schedules.

However, Supreme Court Administrative Order 2017-79 still requires the presiding judges of superior courts to exercise administrative supervision over the justice of the peace courts in their counties, and to exercise administrative supervision over the municipal courts in their counties. Per the Order, presiding judges shall also assist the presiding justice of the peace and presiding municipal court judges in coordinating fine and deposit schedules.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED that Superior Court Administrative Order 2015-002 regarding Uniform Bond Schedules for Maricopa County Limited Jurisdiction Courts is repealed. In addition to this Administrative Order, a new administrative order addressing fines and deposit schedules will be forth coming.
