IT IS FURTHER ORDERED appointing Jason Easterday, as Judge Pro Tempore for the purpose of performing duties of a judge authorized by A.R.S. § 25-121 et seq. and A.R.S. § 12-2222 without specific assignment by the presiding judge, subject to the conditions and limitations of Canon 3, Rule 3.16, Code of Judicial Conduct, effective September 1, 2009 regarding the time and place of any such ceremonies and the receipt of any fee or compensation for performing weddings.
