Modifying ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER No. 2024-037

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the time for the clerk to notify the county recorder that a judgment has been vacated pursuant to Administrative Order No. 2024-037 is extended until December 31, 2026.
