ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 2010-127

Whereas, the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent need for a qualified Spanish<>Chuj and Spanish<>Kanjobal court interpreter owing to a demand for interpretation services for Chuj and Kanjobal speaking defendants and victims/witnesses, and lack of availability of current contractors; and

Whereas, the existing court interpreter vendors do not have qualified and reliable Chuj and Kanjobal language interpreters;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing interpretation to the judicial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of qualified providers. This action will avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring Spanish<>Chuj and Spanish<>Kanjobal interpretation services.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Mr. Domingo Felipe be allowed to work as a Spanish<>Chuj and Spanish<>Kanjobal contract court interpreter during the period October 26, 2010 through December 31, 2011.
2. Mr. Domingo Felipe be compensated according to the terms and conditions of the existing Court Contract for Court Interpreters.
3. Mr. Domingo Felipe be exempt from providing proof of liability and professional insurance.
4. Mr. Domingo Felipe abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for Court Interpreters established by this Court.
