ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Whereas, the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent need for a qualified English<>Serbo-Croatian/Bosnian court transcription and translation services owing to a demand for Serbo-Croatian/Bosnian language translators and lack of availability of current contractors; and

Whereas, the existing court transcription and translation service vendors do not have qualified and reliable Serbo-Croatian/Bosnian language translators;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing transcription and translation services to the judicial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of qualified providers. This action will avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring English<>Serbo-Croatian/Bosnian transcription and translation services.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Mr. Olivera Horwath be allowed to work as an English><Serbo-Croatian/Bosnian contract court translator during the period of September 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011.
2. Ms. Olivera Horwath be compensated at the rates currently offered to other contract transcription and translation services under Court Contract 09013-RFP.
3. Ms. Olivera Horwath abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for Court Interpreters established by this Court.
