WHEREAS, A.R.S. § 8-208(D) authorizes the Juvenile Court, upon request, to release all information in its possession to jail authorities concerning juveniles who have been transferred from Juvenile Court for criminal prosecution and are being held in a county jail pending trial; and

WHEREAS, the Maricopa County Jail has requested psychological information for all youth transferred from Maricopa County Juvenile Detention to the Maricopa County Jail when there is a concern about the health, welfare or safety of the juvenile or those who come in contact with the juvenile; and

WHEREAS, the Maricopa County Juvenile Detention has requested psychological information for all youth transferred from Maricopa County Jail to Maricopa County Juvenile Detention when there is a concern about the health, welfare or safety of the juvenile or those who may come in contact with the juvenile; and

WHEREAS, juvenile psychological information is necessary upon transfer to or from the Maricopa County Jail for classification, treatment, and security,

IT IS ORDERED that the Detention Counseling/Psychological Services of Maricopa County Juvenile Detention may share any psychological reports, information and/or concerns to Maricopa County Correctional Health Services and any clinical liaisons for the Maricopa County Jail about juveniles who are transferred from Juvenile Court for criminal prosecution and are being held in the Maricopa County Jail, and the Maricopa County Jail and Correctional Health Services may share any psychological reports, information and/or concerns to Detention Counseling/Psychological Services of Maricopa County Juvenile Detention. The transmission shall be by any secure means, including but not limited to encrypted email, facsimile, and telephone. Any psychological reports and information provided pursuant to this order shall remain confidential and not subject to disclosure absent a court order specifically authorizing its release or an appropriately executed release. Maricopa County Correctional Health Services and the clinical liaisons for the Maricopa County Jail may share the information necessary for classification, treatment, and security with other jail personnel. However,

Maricopa County Correctional Health Services and the clinical liaisons for the Maricopa County Jail shall take all necessary precautions to ensure any psychological information remains confidential.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Administrative Order expires automatically without further Order on a date ten (10) years from the date of issuance in accordance with Arizona Code of Judicial Administration, Section 3-402(C), unless sooner modified, amended or replaced.
