ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Whereas, the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent and unexpected need for a qualified English<>Burmese and Chin court interpreter for transcription and translation due to a demand for interpretation services for Burmese and Chin speaking defendants, victims and witnesses, and lack of availability of current contractors; and

Whereas, the existing court interpreter vendors do not have qualified and reliable Burmese and Chin language interpreters and translators;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing interpretation, transcription and translation services to judicial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of qualified providers. This action will provide legally required access to justice services, and avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring English<>Burmese and Chin interpretation, transcription and translation services.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Mr. Tom S. Taknan be allowed to work as an English><Burmese and Chin contract interpreter and translator during the period of May 9, 2011 through June 30, 2011.
2. Mr. Tom S. Taknan be compensated according to the terms and conditions under the current Court Contract for court interpreters and transcription and translation services (09013-RFP / 09005-RFQ).
3. Mr. Tom S. Taknan be exempt from providing proof of liability and professional insurance.
4. Mr. Tom S. Taknan abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for Court Interpreters established by this Court.
