WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections has requested permission to review files of juveniles who are or have been on juvenile probation and who have received services from Creative Innovations to determine the effectiveness of the program; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections has agreed to provide a copy of its results to the Maricopa County Juvenile Probation Department and the results will be beneficial to the Maricopa County Juvenile Probation Department;

IT IS ORDERED that John Vivian, Ph.D., Administrator, Research and Development for the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections shall be provided access to files held by Creative Innovations for juveniles who are or have been on probation with the Maricopa County Juvenile Probation Department and received services from Creative Innovations. Dr. Vivian shall have access to the records from the date of execution of this order until January 31, 2012. Dr. Vivian shall not divulge the contents of the records, nor permit others to review the records. Dr. Vivian is authorized to provide summary data, as well as examples from the records that reveal no personally identifying information about any juvenile.
