WHEREAS, the Superior Court must provide for compulsory arbitration of claims pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-133(A);

WHEREAS, Rule 72(a) of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure, authorizes the Superior Court to adopt a compulsory arbitration program upon a majority vote of the judges of the court and a majority of the superior court judges voted to adopt a compulsory arbitration program at the Bench Meeting held on October 5, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Local Rule 3.10 establishes a jurisdictional limit of \$50,000 for submission of disputes to mandatory arbitration;

IT IS ORDERED continuing the compulsory arbitration program in the Superior Court in Maricopa County pursuant to Rules 72 through 77 of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure, subject to the jurisdictional limit provided in Local Rule 3.10.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED affirming the fee of \$75.00 per day for each day or part thereof necessarily expended in the hearing of the case to be paid to the assigned arbitrator.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED vacating Administrative Order No. 91-054.
