WHEREAS, Rule 73(b) of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure requires active members of the State Bar of Arizona who reside in the county and have been members of the State Bar for at least four years to be included on the list from which arbitrators are appointed; and

WHEREAS, Rule 73(d) of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure provides a process to be disqualified or excused from service as an arbitrator;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED terminating all previous orders disqualifying or excusing an active member of the State Bar of Arizona from service as an arbitrator pursuant to Rules 72 through 77 of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure, including Administrative Orders No. 2004-077, 2004-114, 2004-201, and 2005-087.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the judge assigned to the particular case may excuse an arbitrator pursuant to the procedures outlined in Rule 73(d) of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure.
