WHEREAS, when a Justice of the Peace is unable or unwilling to perform his or her duties, Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2008-59 authorizes the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court to designate a judge to perform the duties; and

WHEREAS, the Justice of the Peace for the University Lakes Precinct is temporarily unable to perform the administrative and judicial duties of the position;

IT IS ORDERED appointing Michael Orcutt as a judge pro tempore for the University Lakes Precinct to serve until June 3, 2013 or until a subsequent judge pro tempore administrative order is issued. Any payment arrangements shall be arranged between Michael Orcutt and Maricopa County. While serving as a judge pro tempore under this order for the University Lakes Precinct, Michael Orcutt shall have the authority to exercise the administrative and judicial duties in paragraph 4 of Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2008-59.
