WHEREAS, when a Justice of the Peace is unable or unwilling to perform his or her duties, Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2008-59 authorizes the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court to designate a judge to perform the duties; and

WHEREAS, the Justice of the Peace for the East Mesa Precinct is temporarily unable to perform the administrative and judicial duties of the position;

IT IS ORDERED appointing Don Calender as a judge pro tempore for the East Mesa Precinct to serve until a duly elected or appointed Justice of the Peace takes or returns to office, or until a subsequent judge pro tempore administrative order is issued. Any payment arrangements shall be arranged between Don Calender and Maricopa County. While serving as a judge pro tempore under this order for the East Mesa Precinct, Don Calender shall have the authority to exercise the administrative and judicial duties in paragraph 4 of Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2008-59.
