IN THE MATTER OF JUSTICE OF THE PEACE BUDGET AND EXPENDITURES } ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, Supreme Court Administrative Order 2005-32 directs the presiding judge to “exercise administrative supervision over the justice of the peace courts in their counties;” and

WHEREAS, Supreme Court Administrative Order 2005-32 provides for a coordinated budget submission for the superior court, clerk of the superior court, adult probation, juvenile court, juvenile probation and justice of the peace courts; and

WHEREAS, Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order 2008-40 adopts the Procurement Rules for the Judicial Branch; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court in Maricopa County has adopted the Procurement Rules for the Judicial Branch pursuant to Rule 3 of the Procurement Rules for the Judicial Branch; and

WHEREAS Rule 12 of the Procurement Rules for the Judicial Branch authorizes delegation of the administration of the Procurement Rules to others in the organization;

IT IS ORDERED designating the Presiding Justice of the Peace in Maricopa County as the “respective designee” for the Justice of the Peace Courts in Maricopa County for purposes of the Procurement Rules for the Judicial Branch. The Presiding Justice of the Peace shall follow all statutes, rules and regulations including but not limited to the procurement rules and budget procedures for Maricopa County.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the Presiding Justice of the Peace shall provide the Presiding Judge with a copy of their budget prior to submission to the Board of Supervisors each budget cycle, shall provide routine budget and expenditure updates to the Presiding Judge, and shall consult with the Presiding Judge when questions arise regarding extraordinary or unusual expenditures.
