ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
NO. 2013-133

Whereas the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent need for a qualified English<>German court interpreter owing to a demand for interpretation services for German speaking defendants and victims and witnesses, and lack of availability of current contractors; and

Whereas the existing court interpreter vendors do not have qualified and reliable German language interpreters;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing interpretation to the judicial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of qualified providers. This action will avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring English<>German interpretation services. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Ms. Arianna Schneider-Stocking, a California registered court interpreter and owner of InSync Communications, Inc., be allowed to work as an English<>German contract court interpreter during the period May 3, 2013 through June 30, 2014.
2. Ms. Arianna Schneider-Stocking be compensated at the rate of \$750.00 per day for in-person assignments, with a minimum of 8 hours per day. All travel, lodging and ground transportation expenses will be borne by the Court. In addition, Arianna Schneider-Stocking will receive a per diem of up to \$50.00 per day provided that receipts are submitted with invoice.
3. Ms. Arianna Schneider-Stocking be exempt from providing proof of liability and professional insurance.
4. Ms. Arianna Schneider-Stocking abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for Court Interpreters established by this Court.
