ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
NO. 2013-140

Whereas the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County is experiencing an urgent need for a qualified English<>Grebo and English<>Grebo by the Seaside court interpreter owing to a demand for interpretation services for Grebo and Grebo by the Seaside speaking defendants, victims and witnesses, and lack of availability of current contractors; and

Whereas the existing court interpreter vendors do not have qualified and reliable Grebo and Grebo by the Seaside language interpreters;

Due to these circumstances and the urgency in providing interpretation services to judicial divisions and other vital court programs, it is necessary to temporarily engage the services of qualified providers. This action will avoid delays and continuances of cases requiring English<>Grebo and Grebo by the Seaside interpretation services. Therefore,

**IT IS ORDERED:**

1. Writhers Nyenie-Wea, employee of Midwest Interpreting/Translation Services (MITS), be able to work as an English<>Grebo and Grebo by the Seaside contract court interpreter during the period August 1, 2013 – June 30, 2014.
2. Writhers Nyenie-Wea, employee of Midwest Interpreting/Translation Services (MITS), be compensated at the rate of \$75.00 per hour for in-person assignments, with a minimum of 8 hours per day. For telephonic interpretation, the rate will be \$45.00 for the first 30 minutes, then \$1.50 per minute thereafter. All travel, lodging and ground transportation expenses will be borne by the Court. In addition, Writhers Nyenie-Wea will receive a per diem of up to \$50.00 per day provided that receipts are submitted with invoice.
3. Writhers Nyenie-Wea, employee of Midwest Interpreting/Translation Services (MITS), be exempt from providing proof of liability and professional insurance.

4. Withers Nyenie-Wea, employee of Midwest Interpreting/Translation Services (MITS), abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct for Court Interpreters established by this Court.
