WHEREAS, the presiding judge in each county exercises administrative supervision of the court pursuant to the Arizona Constitution, Article 6, Section 11, and enters administrative orders in the exercise of that administrative supervision; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Code of Judicial Administration Section 3-402 provides that administrative orders should be evaluated after ten (10) years and re-issued if the contents of an administrative order are still valid; and

WHEREAS, Superior Court has for many years entered and approved various Administrative Orders, policies and procedures to regulate and manage the operation of the Municipal and Justice Courts in Maricopa County; and

WHEREAS, Administrative Order No. 2002-070 is now outdated or inconsistent with other superseding orders, policies and procedures;

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order No. 2002-070 is hereby vacated in its entirety. (Vacated does not mean that the order was not necessary at the time entered or invalid for the period it was in effect.)

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all policies and procedures, if any, associated with or adopted pursuant to the issuance of Administrative Order No. 2002-070 are also hereby rescinded and eliminated.
